You will be taking TWO proctored tests TEST 1 Parts A and B **June 18-June 25**. This test covers Chapters 1-5. This test will come directly from your notes, assigned readings, digital slides, audio lectures, labs, and Mastering assignments. Chapters 2-3 will be less emphasized, but will include basic content that I asked you to review during week 1. You are NOT allowed to use books, notes, or study aides on the test. You will be taking TWO proctored tests TEST 2 Parts A and B **July 2-July 9**. This test covers Chapters 6-8. This test will come directly from your notes, assigned readings, digital slides, audio lectures, labs, and Mastering assignments. Please check with your proctoring center for holiday closures. PRC will be closed on July 4-5. You are NOT allowed to use books, notes, or study aides on the test. Remember Academic Honesty from your syllabus. If you use BVirtual, you must have a webcam and required computer setup (they will test this) in order to use this service. Also, if you change or try to reschedule within 24 hours of the final exam time, SmarterProctoring may not allow you to easily change your appointment time. It will be to your advantage to schedule your proctored exams early and keep your appointments. Exams times will not be extended.
